Dear Parents and Guardians,

As a part of our efforts to ensure that students get the best possible start to high school, we are proud to offer a 3-day, 2-night camp for all incoming Grade 9 students. This initiative has been very successful in our school to help transition our new students to high school and to create friendships with students from all elementary schools attending WHSS for the first time. Given the value of this trip, we anticipate that most, if not all of our Grade 9 students will attend, and therefore overnight spaces will be limited to students who respond first with the attached permission forms and payment on the day of Grade 9 Orientation, Wednesday, August 28, 2024.

The camp we will attend is Camp Ki Wa Y in St. Clements. The trip will take place from Wednesday, September 25th until Friday, September 27th and students will either depart from and return to WHSS or the Arthur Looney Tooney parking lot.

This camp is designed to provide an opportunity to develop students' leadership, teamwork, and communication skills, as well as provide an opportunity for students to challenge themselves to achieve their goals. This trip will also go a long way to helping students form new friendships that may last a lifetime. We hope that through this trip, students will feel part of the WHSS community - a community of which they will be a part for the next four years.

There is a wide array of activities at the camp including team-building initiatives, low ropes, orienteering, high ropes, a climbing wall, and many more. The highly qualified staff at the camp will ensure students are safe, comfortable, and well-supervised for all activities. If students are uncomfortable participating in a particular activity, alternate programming will be provided. WHSS staff, as well as senior student members of the WHSS LINK Crew student mentorship program will also be at the camp to help create a great experience for all Grade 9 students.

The cost of the 3-day overnight trip for each student will be \$200. Students will need to eat a hearty, healthy breakfast on the morning of the trip and bring a refillable water bottle. All other meals will be provided. Special food and dietary restrictions can be indicated on the medical form for your child. While we encourage students to participate in the full Grade 9 Camp experience, we understand that some students may not be able to stay overnight. Students will also have the option to participate in an extended 1-day trip to Camp Ki Wa Y on September 26th at a cost of \$65.

Attached to this letter you will find the permission and medical forms; please complete and return these forms at the Grade 9 Orientation day on Wednesday, August 28th or on the first day of school on Wednesday, September 4th.

A parent information meeting for the trip will be held at Wellington Heights at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 28th just after you drop off your child for Grade 9 Orientation day. Alternately, parents or guardians with questions about the trip or about arranging an alternative payment schedule can contact Principal Brent Bloch at 519-323-3430 ext. 222. If you are unable to bring your Grade 9 student to WHSS on Grade 9 Orientation day, please send your child with the attached camp permission forms. Payment can be made on School Cash Online beginning in late August. We look forward to welcoming your child to Wellington Heights, and to helping them build positive relationships from the start at camp!


