1. Policy Statement

It is the policy of the Upper Grand District School Board to promote and embed responsible and sound environmental practices within all areas of the board.

The board is strongly committed to leadership in the development of knowledge, skills, perspectives, and practices in order to foster environmentally responsible citizens.

2. Details

- 2.1 It is the responsibility of the appropriate superintendents to administer this policy.
- 2.2 It is the responsibility of principals to implement this policy in all UGDSB schools.
- 2.3 It is the responsibility of all department managers to implement this policy in all board departments.
- 2.4 It is the responsibility of principals and department managers to maintain school and work environments which reflect the goals of this policy.
- 2.5 It is the responsibility of all board employees and trustees to promote environmental education and management in schools, worksites and within the larger community, through participation.
- 2.6 It is the responsibility of the board to establish and maintain an Environmental Education and Management Committee comprised of staff, students and trustees to implement this policy.
