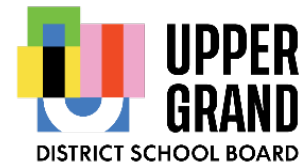


# Provision of Learning Resources Policy 603

## 1. Policy Statement

It is the policy of the Upper Grand District School Board to provide a wide range of acceptable learning resources at varying levels of difficulty, with diversity of appeal and representing different points of view to meet the needs of students and teachers.

## 2. Details

- 2.1 It is the responsibility of the appropriate Superintendent to administer this policy in accordance with the Provision of Learning Resources Procedures Manual 603-A.
- 2.2 It is the responsibility of Principals, teachers and program staff to select learning resources for use in the schools, and in consultation, when appropriate, with students and the community.
- 2.3 It is the responsibility of the Principal to use the Procedures for the Reconsideration of Learning Resources, as outlined in the Procedures Manual, when responding to challenges of specific learning resources.
- 2.4 Formal complaints on the use of specific learning resources will be registered, in writing, on the Request for Reconsideration of Learning Resources Form 603-1.
