For UGDSB Grade 12 Core French & FI Students

The **Diplôme d'études en langue Française (DELF)** is an internationally recognized exam that measures French proficiency across four competencies: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The DELF exam has two parts; a written exam and an oral interview.

The DELF is optional. Students interested in taking either the B1 or B2 test are invited to apply.
